Rules referred to by numbers are the Rules for the Government of the Operating Department, unless otherwise specified.

M. OTHER RAILROADS.

Between Madison St. and Troy, trains run via T. U.
Between Green Island and Troy, trains run via T. U. and D. & H.

N2. THIRD RAIL.

Cars that do not clear third rail telltales or indicator blocks must not be run where there is a third rail. Conductors must know that cars in their trains clear telltales before trains are operated between Kirkville Jct. and South Utica.

Prompt reports must be made to the trainmaster at Utica, and nearest sub station of all accidents and trouble, when necessary to shut off current and when trouble is cleared.

When the current is shut off a section of the third rail, the third rail is to be considered alive up to the point of trouble.

When the electric power has been off and is restored, electric trains must wait one half minute before starting, to permit proper distribution of power.

O. OBSERVANCE OF PASSING TRAINS.

When trains are passing, trainmen of freight trains must observe the general condition of trains on other tracks for entire length of each train.

When a freight train is standing, trainmen of that train must place themselves in best position on ground to observe running gear of passing passenger trains, and, when other duties do not interfere, the same observation must be made of passing freight trains.

When approaching track pans or immediately after passing them, and frequently at other points, rear trainmen must observe each side of their train.

When trains are passing, signalman or operator, whenever practicable, must observe from signal station or station platform, the condition of the train for its entire length. Trackmen, bridgemen, signal maintainers, pumpers and other employes must make similar observations.

If any indication of conditions endangering a train is observed, "stop" signal must be given. If there are no apparent defects, employes, except crossing watchmen, must give "Proceed" signal.

All signals must be acknowledged.

Passenger trainmen will comply with the above as far as practicable.

DEFINITION.

Communicating Station.—A station where an operator or signalman is on duty, or where a trainman may communicate by telephone with train dispatcher, signalman or operator.

Rule 6a is eliminated.

12. HAND, FLAG AND LAMP SIGNALS.

A blue signal displayed from a signal station indicates train is to back from Track No. 1 or Track No. 2. Clear signal will be displayed only after whistle signal acknowledgment has been received.

A white signal displayed from a signal station indicates that train on Track No. 3 or Track No. 4 should take water at the next water station.

The following will be used when giving signals in connection with Special Instruction O where other signals are not required.

By day: Nose held with right hand, and left hand pointed toward track.	Hot journal.
By night: Lamp swung vertically in small circle; lamp to be held by guard wire around globe.	Hot journal.

Second paragraph of Rule 14 (k) applies to single track territory only. Rule 14 is modified accordingly.

17. HEADLIGHTS.

When rules require the headlight to be displayed, it must be dimmed while passing through yards where yard engines are employed; approaching stations at which stops are to be made or where trains are receiving or discharging passengers; approaching train order signals, junctions, terminals, or meeting points or standing on main track at meeting points and on two or more tracks when approaching trains in the opposite direction.

19. MARKERS.

Trains with rear car not equipped to display markers, as per Rule 19, will display red flag by day and red light by night on rear of train.

21. EXTRA TRAINS.

Extra trains will omit the display of white signals on two or more tracks.

34. COMMUNICATION OF SIGNAL INDICATIONS.

Indication of signals day and night will be communicated as follows: "red," "yellow" or "green." When other than the top arm or top light of an interlocking signal is "yellow" or "green" add "middle arm" or "middle light" or "bottom arm" or "bottom light" as the case may be. Rule 34 is modified accordingly.

83. CLEARING OF TRAINS.

On two or more tracks trains will be cleared at initial stations by signal indication.

Passenger trains must be given full protection at all times. Rule 93 is modified accordingly.

94. DELAYED TRAINS.

On double track, in automatic signal territory, when a train is delayed or disabled so that delay will result to following first-class trains, the conductor will immediately arrange to flag such trains around on opposite main tracks. Where possible, authority should first be obtained from the Superintendent; if this is impracticable, full information must be telegraphed the Superintendent as soon as possible.

When making movements against current of traffic, passenger trains and trains following passenger trains must be held until track is clear to next signal station or point where flagman is stationed.

In making such movements two flagmen must be used to hold trains running with the current of traffic, one at the cross-over where diverted trains return to their proper track, and one a sufficient distance beyond to stop and notify trains before they reach such cross-over. The conductor in charge must make his instructions to his flagmen clear and explicit, in writing if practicable, and flagmen must repeat the instruction so as to avoid misunderstanding. Trains must not move over a track so used without personal instructions from the conductor in charge. Where possible the Superintendent will notify conductors and enginemen of all trains involved of the conditions and instruct them to report at a designated point to the conductor in charge. If authority has been received from the Superintendent for such movement, normal operation must not be resumed without his permission; and under any conditions, whenever the obstructed track is again in use, the conductor in charge must provide for notice to conductors and enginemen who have been instructed to report to him and who have not arrived with their trains at the designated point.

97. WORK EXTRAS.

On double track, or three or more tracks, conductors of work extras must advise Superintendent by wire before leaving initial station, specifying working limits, and must not proceed beyond such limits without permission from Superintendent. When work is completed for the day and train clear of main track, conductors must so report.

*A signal indicating stop may be passed only on hand signal from trainman standing on crossing. Trainman must, before giving hand signal, observe that all signals governing movements over crossing are indicating stop, that no train is approaching on any track, and then only after he has unlocked box at crossing and opened crossing switch. After train passes crossing switch must be closed and box locked.

*A train standing on Tracks No. 6 or No. 8 east of crossing, Track No. 5 or eastward siding west of crossing, must not pass "clearing section" signs located 120 feet in rear of dwarf signals governing movements from these tracks except to move over crossing.

**Trains and engines must proceed over N. Y. S. only on proceed hand signals from member of crew who will precede train or engine over crossing.

Freight trains on Track No. 1 or Track No. 2 having crippled cars to leave at signal stations will stop before engine passes home signal so that train may be diverted.

A train must not go to a non-communicating station to be met or passed by other trains, unless the conductor and engineman have received a train order authorizing the movement and, in addition, have received a Permissive Card and a Clearance Card. Rule 917 is modified accordingly.

Signalman must not permit a train to go to a non-communicating station to be met or passed by other trains until a train order, a Permissive Card and a Clearance Card have been delivered to the engineman and conductor authorizing the movement. When such orders are given the block signal must not be cleared. Rule 951 is modified accordingly.

Issuance of permissive cards, or display of permissive signal, will be authorized by the train dispatcher except in case of failure of communication. Rule 963 is modified accordingly.

Cars with hot journals must not be left on any track in close proximity to where gasoline is loaded or unloaded.

South Schenectady:

Engines of eastward freight trains Track No. 4 stopping to leave cars must cut off west of switches at west end of yard.

1269. OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC CROSSINGS.

Canajoharie: Trains stopping for water must not obstruct crossing east of water column.

Herkimer, Signal Station 26: Trains on Track No. 4 stopping west of home signal must stop west of Caroline St. crossing.

St. Johnsville: Trains obstructing first farm crossing east of coal trestle and west of Signal Station 22 must clear crossings promptly when necessary. Rule 1269 is modified accordingly.

1305. ENGINEMEN.

When it becomes apparent that something is wrong with the valve gear of engines handling trains, the train must be brought to a stop immediately, proper investigation made and necessary action taken. Rule 1305 is modified accordingly.

1307. AIR BRAKES.

When stopping freight trains of 25 or more cars for water or coal, air brakes must be applied by engineman and engine detached, unless, in the judgment of the engineman, it is unnecessary. If on a grade, hand brakes must be applied to hold train. While taking coal or water, engine brake must be held applied. Rule 1549 of the Rules for the Operation and Supervision of Air Brake, Train Air Signal and Steam Heat Equipment is modified accordingly.

Eastward Freight Trains.

Between Voorheesville and Selkirk Yard.
Pressure retaining valves are to be turned up, the number on each train will be left to the judgment of the engineman in accordance with Rule 1558 of the Rules for the Operation and Supervision of Air Brake, Train Air Signal and Steam Heat Equipment.

Conductors and Enginemen will have an understanding as to the number of retainers to be used before arrival at Voorheesville.

Signal Station 4 to Signal Station 1.

All pressure retaining valves must be turned up before leaving Signal Station 4 or West Albany yard.

On trains departing from or running through West Albany yard running test must be made at Rock Cut. Other freight trains must be stopped by air brakes at Signal Station 4 and running test made at automatic signal 14692.

The brake pipe pressure must be 85 pounds. Should pressure be reduced below 60 lbs., trains must be stopped and not proceed until full pressure is restored. Engines with air pump capacity of less than New York No. 5 or Westinghouse eleven inch must not be used in this service.

In case of failure of air brakes, enginemen will immediately place brake valve in emergency position and sound whistle 14 (a). Train must be stopped as quickly as possible.

Enginemen and conductors must be specially qualified before taking charge of freight trains.

1308. PUSHER ENGINES.

Pusher Limit Signs located west of South Schenectady and west of Verona, indicates where pusher engines will be uncoupled from freight trains.

When trains are stalled on Albany grade and following train has a pusher, the engine must be cut off before assisting.

1401. SPEED RESTRICTIONS.

Speed restrictions are shown in miles per hour and apply to the entire train.

1402. ENGINE AND CAR RESTRICTIONS.

Main Line, West Shore and Branches:

Steam engines must not be coupled head on when double heading or running light. In case of emergency, instructions should be obtained from Superintendent. Engines, Class J, must not operate over Branches and Canastota Connection. Engines, Classes J and K-14 with 15,000-gallon tanks, must not be operated over bridges in private sidings.

Engines, Classes H and L must not be operated over Hudson River passenger bridge. Engines and cars must not be operated on sidings and coal trestles as follows:

1405. SPECIAL USE OF TRACKS.

Yard engines or trains having work to do at outlying switches must obtain permission from signalman or train dispatcher before using switches in main tracks.

1406. TELEPHONES.

Conductors and enginemen must use telephone whenever necessary to facilitate the movement of trains. Instructions received by telephone must be repeated and name and occupation of the employes exchanged to avoid misunderstanding.

1801. AUTOMATIC TRAIN STOP.

All road engines operating between Albany and Syracuse, Main Line, must have train stop device cut in and in working order. Enginemen and Firemen must be qualified on Rules for Enginemen and Firemen for Operation of Automatic Train Stop.

In case of failure of any part of locomotive which renders train stop device in-operative, engineman will notify train dispatcher and a relief engine should be furnished at first engine terminal.
