When using Middle No. 1, and Tappan, Congers and Morgan's Middles, West-bound trains will not run West or East-bound trains East of center cross-overs without flag protection. Cross-over at Bergenfield is center cross-over of Middle No. 1.

The single track between West end of Kingston West Yard and KY Tower is to be kept open for East-bound movements into the West yard. West-bound movements over this track must be under protection of flag.

9. Use of Main Tracks.

Single track is in use between—

Ravena and Kenwood Junction.

Kingston and Montgomery.

Double track is in use between—

P. R. R. Junction and Ravena.

When running on double track trains will keep to the right.

10. Recalling Flagmen.

Flagmen must not be recalled when in the judgment of the conductor or engineman the conditions are not favorable.

Flagmen must not be recalled by the whistle of the engine when flagging trains in a direction against traffic, but must be sent for when track has been cleared.

12. Train Order or Clearance Card.

The clearance cards must be authorized by the train dispatcher, except in case of wire failure, when they may be issued by operators, provided they have no train orders for train to which issued. Train orders addressed to "all concerned" or to "all trains" do not fulfill these requirements.

When using cross-overs or switches to and from main tracks or sidings, trains must not exceed a speed of ten miles per hour, or as much less as may be necessary to insure absolute safety, and must proceed only as the way is known to be clear.

15. Block Signals.

(See Book of Block Signal Rules effective March 15, 1906.)

Telegraph block signals are in use between—

National Junction.....and...New Durham.

Newburgh.....and...Kenwood Junction.

Kingston.....and...Montgomery.

Train order signals will be used as block signals between Ravena and Kenwood Junction, and between Kingston and Montgomery.

Telegraph block signals are located at National Junction, Willow Avenue and all telegraph offices West of Newburgh except Glenmont and West Camp.

Willow Avenue will be open day and night.

A caution signal is in use at Saugerties (East-bound). (See Rule 605, Book of Block Signal Rules.)

Rule 609, Book of Block Signal Rules, is amended as follows:

If circumstances render it necessary to card a passenger train into an occupied block or to card another train into a block occupied by a passenger train, it will be done after the operator has secured a 19 order for the train to be carded, and the train which is so forwarded must have a caution card, Form 132, in addition to the train order. When a train is so carded it will be held until ten (10) minutes after the departure of the preceding train.

When any train enters a block on caution card or caution signal, it must move through the block at a speed that will admit of stopping within the vision of the engineman.

Rules for Reverse Blocking on Single Track (modifying Rules 608, 609 and 613, Book of Block Signal Rules).

Code	74—Display stop signal.
	75—Block clear.
	76—Block wanted.
	77—Train has entered block.
	78—Block is not clear.

To admit train into block operator must examine block record, and, if block is clear, give "74" for (Train No.....) to next block station in advance. The operator receiving this signal, if block is clear, must display stop signal to opposing trains and reply "S D" for (Train No.....). If block is not clear, he must reply "78" of (Train No.....). The operator at entrance of block must then display proper signal indication to the train to be admitted.

If the block is already occupied by train in opposite direction, a train must not be admitted to the block unless movement is protected by train order or caution card.

"Proceed" indication of telegraph block signals applies only to main track, and trains on sidings must not accept such indication.

Weehawken tunnel is operated under an absolute block. All trains and engines passing through this tunnel must display markers and in addition one or more red lights to the rear.

Signalmen in charge of the block stations at each end of the tunnel will report by telegraph to the Superintendent any train entering or leaving the block without proper markers.

All trains entering the North Yard at Weehawken must stop before passing the stop board 270 feet east of the tunnel, unless signal 21 is set at clear and signal to proceed is given by the switchman at junction of "Y" and yard tracks. This signal indicates position of switches only.

All trains passing through Haverstraw and West Point tunnels will display one or more red lights to the rear.

The automatic signals between CN Tower and Newburgh are of the single-arm, three-position, upward inclination type, and give the following indications:

Horizontal position, and in addition a red light at night above a fixed red marker light.....Stop.
At an angle of 45 degrees above horizontal and in addition a yellow light at night above a fixed red marker light.....Proceed with caution.
Upward perpendicular position, and in addition a green light at night above a fixed red marker light.....Proceed.

That part of Rule 705 on page 17, and Rules 706 and 707 (with illustrations), Book of Block Signal Rules, are amended accordingly.

Signal No. 57.8, at West end of Cotton Mill Siding, Newburgh, is a distant signal showing only the position of signal No. 57.2.

West-bound track circuit ends 330 feet West of West-bound block signal, Newburgh; and signal 56.3, East of Newburgh, indicates conditions to that point only.

Automatic signals are located 3120 feet West, and 2178 feet East of Kingston Viaduct; and 2940 feet West, and 4200 feet East of Catskill Viaduct. Sign boards indicate the ends of track circuits.

Automatic disc signals are located at Newburgh, for protection of trains at the station, 325 feet West, and 625 feet East of the station. When indicating caution trains will proceed with care, expecting to find a train approaching or at the station, on the opposite track. These signals will not relieve engineers from proper observance of Rule 108, Book of Rules of the Operating Department.

A permissive block signal, as referred to in Rule 708, Book of Block Signal Rules, effective March 15, 1906, is an automatic block signal, pointed at the end, and painted red, as shown in sketch under Rule 705.

The top arms of the following automatic signals have square ends, indicating positive block; when in stop position, trains will proceed through tunnels mentioned under flag protection:

- 29.5 East of Haverstraw Tunnel.
- 30.4 West of Haverstraw Tunnel.
- 42.3 East of Fort Montgomery Tunnel.
- 43.2 West of Fort Montgomery Tunnel.

At Little Ferry Drawbridge, the bridge signals in the direction of traffic have square ends, indicating positive block; when in stop position, if it is known that drawbridge is closed and locked, trains may proceed over the bridge under flag protection.

A wire is attached to each side of Haverstraw, Fort Montgomery and West Point Tunnels, about four feet above track level, and connected with switch boxes outside of and near portals of these tunnels. The breaking of these wires will cause the automatic signals, immediately East and West of the tunnel, to indicate stop. Employees will break the wire promptly should track be obstructed or not in safe condition for passage of trains in either direction.

Boxes containing switches connected with automatic signal circuits are located on each telegraph pole—

FROM	TO
(District No. 1)—Automatic signal 39.1	Automatic signal 40.8
(District No. 2)—Automatic signal 45.7	Automatic signal 46.4

The opening of one of these switches in any of the three districts will cause all of the automatic signals in that district to indicate stop.

Each box is equipped with a door, opened by turning a button, and a glass, which it is necessary to break before switch can be used.

When either track in the districts covered by this protection is obstructed or unsafe for the passage of trains at usual speed, employees having knowledge of such conditions must, as an additional precaution, in addition to affording other protection required, open one of these switches.

Interlocking signals and switches are in use at Willow Avenue, Weehawken, New Durham, Granton, Iona Island, Cornwall, Newburgh, Kingston and Ravena. Blue prints, showing the location of the tracks and signals, are posted in the block stations at the points named, and all concerned are required to familiarize themselves with the uses of the signals.

At interlocking block stations, trains must not pass signals at stop, except on receipt of clearance card. Hand signals must not be given to pass a fixed signal at stop.

To avoid stalling on West Nyack grade, West-bound freight trains should get proceed indication of both home and distant arms at signal 23.1.

Switch indicators are placed at each main track switch between West Haverstraw and Newburgh, and must be consulted before position of switch is changed for movement from siding to main track, or from one main track to the other. When the miniature semaphore arm in switch indicator box is in stop position (before position of switch is changed) it indicates:

At cross-over switches from one main track to the other	- Train approaching in first or second block on opposite main track, or - Train in first block in advance of switch on opposite main track, or both.
At other switches	- Train approaching in first or second block to rear of indicator consulted, or - Train in first block in advance of indicator consulted, or both.

The normal position of train order signals in automatic signal territory, at Kingston station (main line), and at Ravena station (main line), will be at proceed.

The top arms of automatic signals 28.4 and 28.7 at Congers, 33.5 at West Haverstraw, 46.4 at Highland Falls, 47.5 at West Point, and 52.2 and 52.5 at Cornwall, have square ends, indicating positive block, and will be used as train order signals; when in stop position, trains will not proceed without receiving clearance card, Form 92.

The block signals at KC Tower, East-bound, KY Tower, West-bound, and the West-bound block signal at Newburgh will also be used as train order signals.

Engines must not stop on the drawspans.

126. On double track, when a train is delayed or disabled so that delay will result to following first-class trains, the conductor will immediately arrange to flag such trains around on the opposite main track. When possible, authority should first be obtained from the Superintendent; if this is impracticable full information must be sent the Superintendent by wire as soon as possible.

In making such movements two flagmen must be used to hold trains running with the current of traffic, one at the cross-over where diverted trains return to their proper track, and one a sufficient distance beyond to stop and notify trains before they reach such cross-over. The conductor in charge must make his instructions to his flagmen clear and explicit, in writing if practicable, and flagmen

must repeat the instructions so as to avoid misunderstanding. Trains must not move over a track so used in both directions without personal instructions from the conductor in charge. When possible the Superintendent will notify conductors and enginemen of all trains involved of the conditions, and instruct them to report to the conductor in charge at a designated point. If authority has been received from the Superintendent for such movements, normal operation must not be resumed without his permission; and under any conditions whenever the obstructed track is again in use the conductor in charge must provide for notice to trains which have been instructed to report to him and which have not arrived at the designated points.

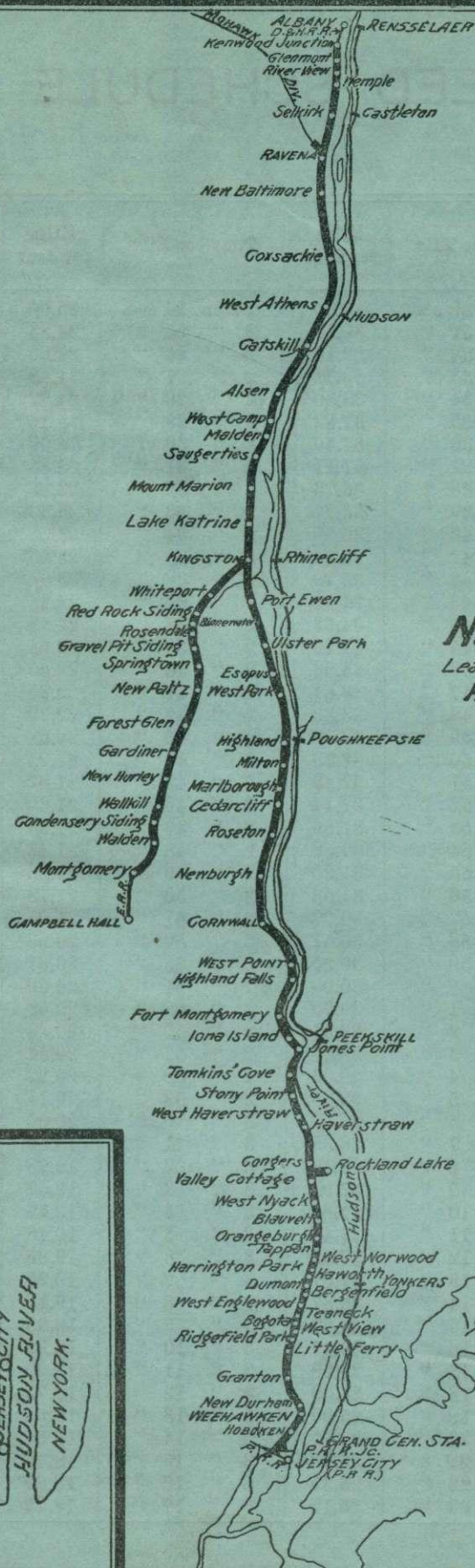
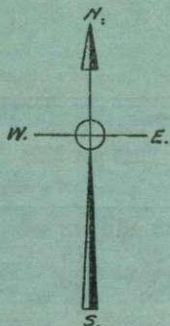

Employees must use these telephones whenever necessary to facilitate the movement of trains. Instructions received or delivered by telephone **must** be repeated and names and occupation of the employees exchanged to avoid misunderstanding. Except in cases of emergency, conductors will use the telephone **personally**. Telephones located on telegraph poles and in cabins are protected by switch locks.

Conductors of trains using sidings adjacent to open telegraph offices, or sidings where telephones are located, will remain at such telegraph office or telephone, or have some member of the train crew so stationed, so that the Train Dispatcher can communicate with them (if necessary) without delay.
